FREE RIDES

MCKINNEY AVENUE TROLLEY (M-LINE)

Restored vintage trolley cars ride along McKinney Avenue and connect Uptown and Downtown.

- Sat 10 - 12 a.m.
- Sun and holidays 10 a.m. - 10 p.m.

DALLAS STREETCAR

Dallas Streetcar is a 1.6 mile dedicated streetcar track that connects commuters in Oak Cliff to the Dallas Union Station.

- Mon-Fri 9:30 - 12 a.m.
- Streetcar runs every 30 minutes

Where can you go?

Dallas Union Station, Reunion District, Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center, Oak Cliff

DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART) LIGHT RAIL

Daily 4 - 12 a.m.

\$2.50 2-hour pass/\$5 day pass

DART is the longest light rail system in the country with over 90 miles of rail lines.

WHERE CAN YOU GO?

DART connects you to all Dallas entertainment districts, Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center, American Airlines Center, DFW and Love Field airports, as well as Trinity Rail Express (TRE).

TRINITY RAIL EXPRESS (TRE)

Mon-Sat 4 - 12 a.m.

\$5-10 day pass

TRE is a rail service provided jointly by DART and the Fort Worth Transportation Authority (the T).

WHERE CAN YOU GO?

TRE connects Dallas and Fort Worth. And offers free WiFi!

D-LINK (BY DART)

Bus service provided by DART.

- Mon-Sat 11 a.m. - 11:30 p.m.
- Buses run every 15 minutes

Where can you go?

Uptown, Victory Park, Dallas Arts District, West End, Downtown, Cedars/Southside, Bishop Arts District, Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center, American Airlines Center

Get up-to-date train and bus schedules and purchase passes with GoPass, a free mobile ticketing app. DART.org/gopass
